Overall it was one of the memorable, interesting, valuable trips to the students.

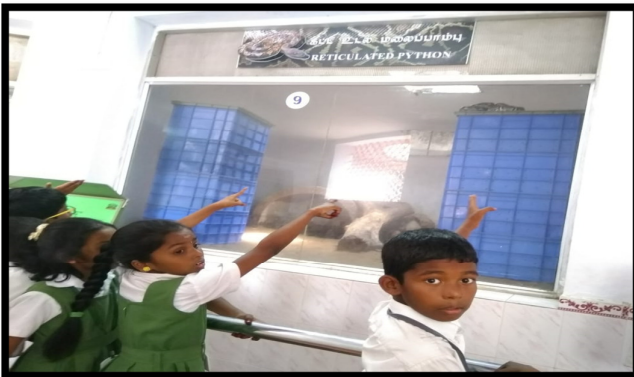
