

Educational Trip Report - Class 1 – Post Office and Vegetable Shop

The students of class 1 were taken for an educational trip to IIT Post Office and a vegetable shop inside the IIT campus. We started from school around 9.30 am by IIT bus accompanied by few non teaching staff member and Parent volunteers on 10/10/19, with an intent of bringing the real life, practical knowledge into class room experiences.

The visit to the post office gave a better understanding of the role and responsibilities of the postmaster and the postman. Children observed and named them. Later they could identify by their colour and size. Then as a token of love they gifted our children an apple and a banana stressing the importance of fruits and to consume it every day. The students enjoyed the trip and returned happily.
