

Report on std 1 - Excursion to Guindy National Park

The students of class I were taken for an excursion to the Guindy National Park - Chennai near our IIT Campus on 21.02.2020. We started from school around 9.30 a.m. with 118 students, four teachers and eight parent volunteers.

We reached the picnic spot at around 10.00 a.m. First, we saw deers and black bucks. We saw the butterfly garden and near to that water birds like pelicans, egret and beautiful spoon billed crane. Then we saw colourful love birds and peacocks. We learnt about the largest birds like emu and ostrich and their differences in their appearance. Then we saw varieties of monkeys, parakeets, crocodiles, turtles, tortoise, jackals, wild cat and snakes with their prey in the cage. The students were excited to see hens and rats inside the snake's case waiting to be its prey.

Then we started from there and reached our school by 2.30 p.m. The students commented that they played well and also had a live experience seeing different animals by chattering, barking, howling, chirping, speaking with animals and counting the animals.
