WORLD PHOTOGRAPHY DAY

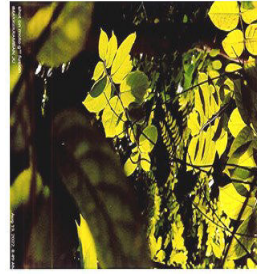
