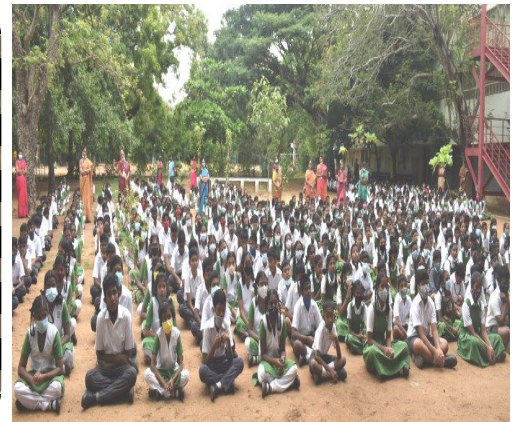
ALUMNUS TALK WITH STUDENTS

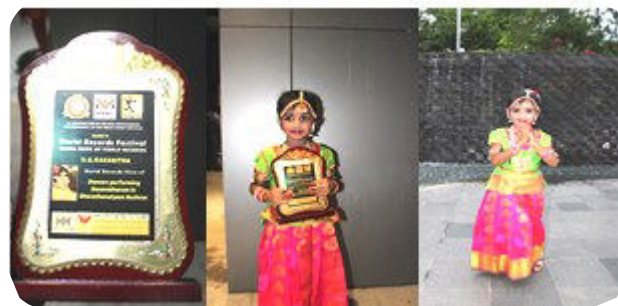
WORKSHOP ON QUALITY ASSURANCE AND ACCREDITATION FOR SCHOOL EDUCATION
