NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS 2023 BY ANNA UNIVERSITY ALONG WITH TAMIL NADU STATE COUNCIL FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY.

National Science Day Celebrations 2023 was organised by Anna University along with Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology. (28.02.2023 & 1.03.2023). Students from Std VI to IX participated enthusiastically in all the events, workshops and exhibitions. All participants received a certificate. Winners were given an award and a certificate. Students of IX std also sang a 'Plastic Use Awareness' song on Valedictory Day which was well appreciated. It was an enriching learning experience for the students and teachers.









The event's purpose was to raise awareness about the dangers of cancer and educate students about ways to prevent it.

The chief guest was an alumnus of our school, Dr. Venkatesh Sivanandam. He did his B.S. in biotechnology at Bharathidasan University, India, and completed his Ph.D. in genetics, genomics, and bioinformatics at the

University of California, Riverside. He has a keen knowledge of viral genome replication and packaging, viral-host interaction, virus-tumor immunology, and viral-gene editing.

He recalled his school days and then spoke about virology which can be used in gene therapy to introduce new genes into cancer cells or to modify existing ones to improve treatment outcomes.

The event ended with a Q&A session, where students were encouraged to ask questions about cancer and its prevention. The alumnus answered all the questions and cleared any doubts the students had.

It was a very informative and enlightening event that helped in raising awareness about cancer








March 04, 2023

It featured a variety of exhibits, including working models, charts, and experiments related to different fields of science such as physics, chemistry, biology, and robotics. The students worked hard to prepare their exhibits, which showcased their creativity and knowledge of scientific concepts.
