

### **Std 5 Field Trip – Egmore Museum**

The students of Standard 5 went on a field trip to the Government Museum in Egmore on February 8th, 2024, along with teachers and parent volunteers. The museum's collection included artifacts, numismatics, zoological specimens, sculptures, paintings, and manuscripts that shaped history. Over 300 specimens of animals, including mammals, birds, and reptiles, caught the students' curiosity and excitement.

The visit to the museum sparked their curiosity and kindled their interest to learn fascinating details. They were awestruck to learn how the world changes over time and why. Their excitement grew as they saw objects they hadn't seen before, and they began to take notes about the display, which inspired them to learn more about history, art, and nature. An animated movie about animals was shown in an air-conditioned 3D theater, where children had the chance to feel like they were in the middle of a wild animal habitat. The experience was extensive and it has stimulated interest in learning.

The trip gave them a wonderful opportunity to learn about life skills such as sharing, togetherness, public behavior and forgiveness.
