## **INSTRUCTIONS TO STD. XI -BOARD EXAMINATION**

- The Board exam begins on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2025 (Wednesday). Make a note of the exam dates carefully.
- Students should reach the school by 8.30 a.m. for the exam. There
  will be an assembly/prayer. Instructions will be given by the Chief
  Superintendent after which students will enter their exam rooms by
  9.30 a.m.
- Students to come in proper school uniform Green & Grey (Girls and Boys) on all days. Footwear, books, bags etc. should be left in the allotted rooms in the middle school wing. Belts, ID cards are not allowed. (Room allotment for keeping your belongings will be displayed in the notice board on the exam day).
- Students are allowed to carry only writing material -pen, pencil, eraser, scale etc. in a transparent pouch to the exam hall. Pencil boxes are not allowed. Ensure that wrappers from the eraser and scale are removed.
- Check the notice board every day for seating arrangement. The Nominal roll will be put up on the notice board for the students to refer the exam register number, in case of need.
- Check carefully the top sheet (First Page) of the answer booklet for the details. Students should sign only in the allotted place. They should not write the register numbers anywhere else.
- For core exam the student should mention the booklet series (A or
   B) in the space allotted in the main booklet.
- No paper should be torn away from the booklets and unused pages may be struck out with a pen after verifying if requisite number of questions has been answered.

- Hall tickets will be issued to the students in the examination halls and will be collected back every day after the exam, retained with the school and will be returned to the student only on the last exam date.
- For Business Mathematics & Economics examinations students are allowed to use calculator (ordinary) and hence should bring it for the examination.
- The students should sign in an attendance sheet placed in the Middle school foyer, on the days of the exam.
- Students should not carry their mobile phones with them or any other electronic goods including digital watches. If found it will be confiscated as per the guidelines of Department of Education.
- Students are advised to have a proper breakfast and come well in time for the exam and also leave the campus after the exam is over.
- Students are advised to take care of their health during the study holidays and make optimum use of time to prepare well for the Board Exams. Your teachers are always available to help/clear doubts etc. at school, do not hesitate to get in touch with the teacher or school.
