THE SCHOOL

Vana Vani situated in the campus of the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras, was founded on 8th July 1963 as a primary School with 52 pupils. Today it has grown and developed into a full-fledged Matriculation Higher Secondary School with around 1400 boys and girls on the rolls.

The school is run by the IIT Madras Educational Trust and is managed by a Committee comprising of the Chairman, the Secretary-cum-Treasurer, the Principal, an Educationist of repute and parent representatives.

Located in what was originally a deer park of about 700 acres, IITM is one of the greenest campuses in the city. The school is within easy reach by public transport from any part of the city. The institute offers transport service from the Main gate and Velachery gate to the school for the students residing outside the campus.

THE CURRICULUM

The school prepares its students for the Tamil Nadu Board Examination at the end of Standard X, XI and XII.

The school is co-educational and English is the medium of instruction for all classes. Tamil is compulsory for all classes upto Standard X.

COURSES OFFERED AT HIGHER SECONDARY LEVEL

Part I : One of the following languages: TAMIL / SANSKRIT / FRENCH

Part II : English (Compulsory for all)

Part III : Any one of the following Groups

Group 1 : Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology.

Group 2 : Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science.

Group 3 : Accountancy, Commerce, Economics, Business Mathematics

Group 4: Accountancy, Commerce, Economics, Computer Application.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The school recognizes Physical Education as an integral part of the education system and provides ample space, exposure and encouragement to students to pursue the game of his/her choice.

HOUSE SYSTEM

Every student, Std I onwards, is allotted and identified with one of the four houses, the Cauvery house, the Ganga house, the Godavari house and the Yamuna house.

The aim is to inculcate in the student a sense of team spirit, co-operation and healthy competition. Various inter-house cultural competitions and sport events are held every year. The house that scores the maximum points bags the trophy.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

The school has a well-equipped library with a wide variety of books to quench students' thirst for knowledge.

LIBRARY RULES

1. The rules of the library should be scrupulously adhered to without any deviation.
2. Observe silence in the library.
3. Students are to refrain from eating food /refreshments inside the library.
4. Books will be issued during the library period / between 3.15 pm and 4.00 pm on school working days.
5. A student is allowed to borrow one book for a week.
6. Books should be returned in good condition on or before the due date.
7. In case a book is damaged or lost, the onus will be on the concerned student to replace the same at his/her own cost.
8. In case of late return, a fine of Rs.2/- will be levied for each ensuing day of non-return.
9. Marking, underlining or overwriting on the books, magazines and newspapers are strictly disallowed.
10. Students are not allowed to borrow reference books. However, they can refer and make notes as and when required.
11. At the end of the session, the books are to be placed back in their respective cupboards in the right order.

CLUB ACTIVITIES

The club activities shall be held on every Friday during school hours for the holistic development of students from classes I - VIII.

MEDICAL CHECK UP

A medical check-up will be conducted every year for students by a team of doctors and the parents will be kept updated about their ward's health.

ADMISSION

Admission to classes 1 to 12 shall be based on availability of seats.

ISSUE OF TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

Parents are requested to apply for TC on or before February 2027 in the school office. For any TC applied after 1st May 2027, the Term fees will be forfeited accordingly. The QR code of the TC application form could be scanned for the same purpose. This is done keeping in mind the interest of the new students who wish to be admitted to our school.

REFUND OF CAUTION DEPOSIT

In case a parent applies for TC on or after 1st March 2027, the caution deposit will not be returned under any circumstances. For parents who have applied for TC before the stipulated date, the caution deposit will be refunded. However, if the parent is willing, the caution deposit may be forfeited towards the infrastructural development of the school. If not, it should be collected during the end of the particular academic year (after May month) against the submission of a Request Form with necessary document.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

- ★ Whenever many individuals live together, discipline is necessary and this is especially true of an institution for the education of youth. This discipline is formative, not repressive. It leads the student to develop self control which is essence of a well-ordered and successful life.
- ★ Therefore Vana Vani requires its students to conform to the rules and regulations mentioned below in various aspects for the benefit of the entire school community as well as the individual student.
- ★ We also solicit the co-operation of parents in this regard.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

The **school calendar** serves as a medium for communication between the school and the parents. Therefore it must be brought to school everyday. In case the student loses it, it has to be brought to the notice of the class teacher and a new one should be purchased immediately from the school office.

1. Parents of students of classes Std.I & Std.II should handover a copy of their passport size photo to the class teacher. In case the child is being dropped and picked up by the guardian / auto / van driver, their photo should also be handed over.
2. **Students from Std I are expected to be in school before the first bell which rings at 8.40 a.m. Similarly all the children are expected to leave the school premises within fifteen minutes of the dispersal bell. We believe that it is the responsibility of the parents of Primary Section to pick up their ward from school. No other person (such as a relative, friend, or neighbour) will be permitted to pick up the student unless the parent provides an authorization letter.**
3. A student's late coming / incomplete uniform is recorded. It's the responsibility of the parent to ensure that the student reaches on time. For repeated late coming, the parent may have to meet the Head of the institution.

4. Whenever the Government declares a holiday for all educational institutions in Chennai on account of incessant rain or for any other reason, the school will also remain closed for that day.
5. (i) Students should come in neat uniform and wear polished shoes.
(ii) Girls should wear two plaits unless the hair is very short.
(iii) Boys should trim their hair regularly .
(iv) Shabby appearance should be totally avoided.
(v) Tight / close fitting pants, kurthas are not allowed.
6. Parents are requested not to encourage their wards to wear any gold jewellery or carry money more than necessary. The school is not responsible for theft or loss of the same.
7. Students should converse only in English.
8. Students are expected to avail leave only with prior permission. In case the leave is due to medical reasons, a leave letter along with Medical Certificate, attested by the Principal should be submitted by the student. Parents should not send any medicines for illness and must inform the school authorities if a student has any underlying health issues.
9. Every student should have a minimum of 75% attendance for promotion. A child who comes late without prior permission will be marked absent.
10. **Students should not ride two wheelers (Motors Bikes & Scooters) to school. Students who use public transport / internal transport of IITM are to strictly avoid foot board travelling. Motorised cycles are strictly prohibited by the school. A protective headgear is highly recommended for all students coming by cycle. Students commuting by cycle to stop at the main gate and walk up to the cycle stand.**
11. **When parents commute to school they should use only one gate for entry and exit, should have a valid gate pass, be mindful of the flora and fauna, and follow the speedlimit stipulated by the IITM, inside the campus. Parents' vehicles are not allowed inside the school campus and should park them only in the allotted place(i.e. Opposite to Nursery Section).**

12. Tests/Exams will not be repeated for the students who are absent. The students can however take the test at home in the presence of their parents and submit the answer script to the teacher concerned the next day. The answer script will be evaluated by the teacher but the marks will not be considered.
13. (i) Students should take their Class tests/examinations seriously. If a student resorts to unfair means, he/she will be dealt with severely and will not be allowed to continue writing the exam. In case of repeated offence, the student may risk suspension.
14. (i) Parents are always welcome to the school to ensure the progress of their ward. But you are requested not to disturb the teachers during class hours. However with prior permission, you may contact the class teacher and the subject teacher between 3.15 to and 4.15 pm on any working day. (Monday to Friday).
- (ii) Similarly when a student requires some corrective measures, the parent will be called. The parent is requested to immediately respond, bearing in mind the best interests of the child.
15. Students moving from one classroom to another / labs / library / playground, shall do so in order and shall observe perfect silence on their way.
16. No student shall leave or enter a class without the permission of the teacher. A student found loitering in the school premises shall be seriously dealt with.
17. (I) Students are expected to co-operate in keeping the premises of the school clean.
- (ii) Students should refrain from scribbling on the walls and desks, scattering bits of paper, damaging furniture etc.
- (iii) Any damage caused to school property will be realised from the student/students who is/are responsible for the same.

18. (i) Cell Phones, Smart Watches or other electronic devices should not be brought to school. If a student is caught possessing a Cell Phone, Smart Watches etc., it will be immediately confiscated and will not be returned under any circumstances.
(ii) In case of emergency or need to bring the phone to school, permission should be taken from the class teacher/section Head by both the student and parent.
(iii) The bags of the students will be checked randomly to ensure that they do not possess any cell phones or other electronic items.
(iv) Strict action will be taken against the student who is caught with magazine or literature of indecent content.
19. Parents are requested to advise their wards not to enter into any conversation or accept anything from strangers at any point of time.
20. The student leaders who are invested with the responsibility of maintaining discipline among students are expected to carry out the allotted duty sincerely.
21. Attestation, Bonafide certificate or any other certificate will be issued only after a day's time from the receipt of the requisition letter. If the photo of the student is to be attested, then it should be in school uniform only.
22. With regard to conduct, students shall at all times bear in mind the good name of the institution and will not at any point of time do anything detrimental to the reputation of this institution.
23. Students should avoid using slang and should not indulge in disputes, violence or negative behavior inside and outside the school premises.
24. Parents to volunteer to accompany their children for all Co-curricular activities.
25. In case of any emergency, parent / student should get the permission from the Class teacher and Section head to receive the gate pass and the same to be handed over to the Security before leaving the campus.

26. The school shall follow Schedule A time table on regular basis. Schedule B time table shall be followed on FA(B) / Cycle test. Schedule C on important events of the school like Sports Day, Annual Day etc., as listed in the timetable schedule .
27. **Parents of Std. VI to XII are required to drop off the students at the IITM gates located at Velachery, Taramani, or Adyar .Students to commute to school either using bicycles or use the IITM transport. Parents can accompany their wards on the IITM bus.**
28. Both parents and students must follow the rules and regulations set by IITM as and when they are updated from time to time.
29. If a student does not conform to the prescribed rules and regulations of the school at any point, the parents will be called to meet the Principal. In extreme cases of indiscipline and resorting to unacceptable practices, the student may be asked to leave the school.
