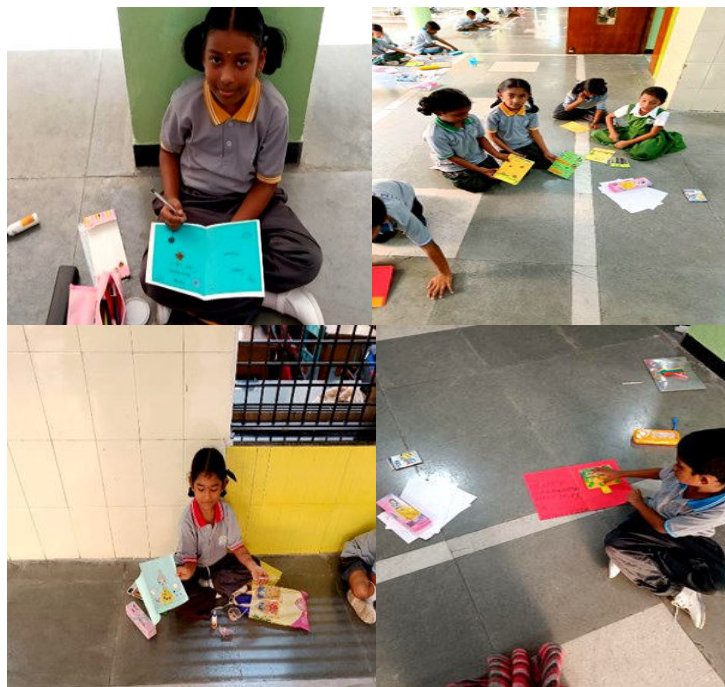

What are the Characteristics of a Psychologically Fit Teacher?
