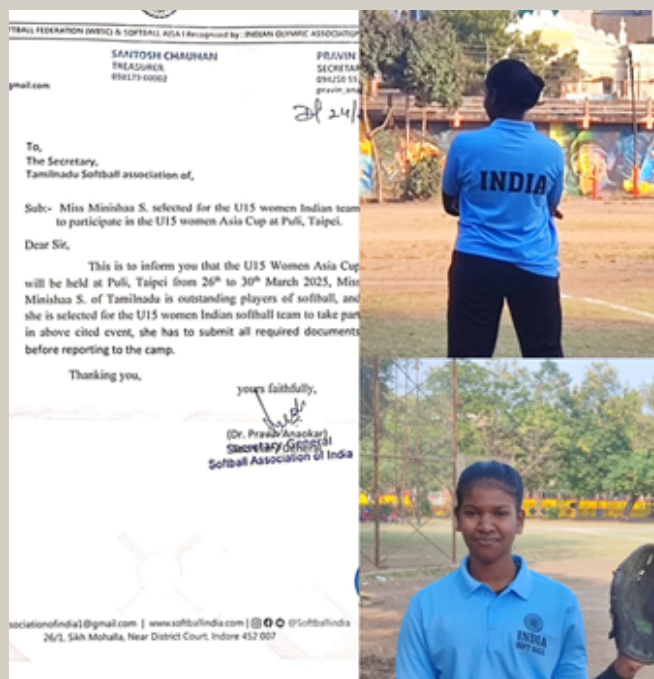

Session on Contribution of CoERS in Road Safety Education

Mrs. R. Akilandeswari, Vice Principal-In-charge, attended an insightful session on the Contribution of the Centre of Excellence in Road Safety (CoERS) in Road Safety Education on 30th January 2025. The session was led by Prof. Venkatesh Balasubramanian from the Department of Engineering Design at IIT Madras. Prof. Venkatesh, a renowned expert in addressing societal issues through Data-Driven Systems, shared his extensive work in the fields of road safety, public policy, human factors, new product development, and lean processes.

As the Head of CoERS, funded by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH), Prof. Venkatesh highlighted key initiatives such as the Integrated Road Accidents Database (IRAD), conceptualized and designed under his guidance to enhance road safety measures across the country. Additionally, he discussed the successful implementation of the TAEI emergency care program in Tamil Nadu, which has significantly reduced road accident fatalities and emergency-related deaths in the state.

The session emphasized the vital role of data-driven approaches in road safety education and policy-making, inspiring educators to integrate road safety awareness into the academic framework.
