

WORKSHOP ON WEB APPLICATION FIREWALL (BARRACUDA)



Mr. Jeeva attended the Workshop on Web Application Firewall (Barracuda) organised by the Computer Centre, IIT Madras, on 02 December 2025 (Tuesday).

The workshop provided a comprehensive overview of Web Application Firewall (WAF) technology, with a special focus on the Barracuda WAF solution. Participants were introduced to the fundamental concepts of web application security, common vulnerabilities, and the role of WAFs in protecting applications from threats such as SQL injection, cross-site scripting, and other web-based attacks. The sessions also included practical insights into configuration, monitoring, and policy management of the Barracuda WAF.



The workshop was informative and beneficial, enhancing participants' understanding of web security practices and strengthening their ability to safeguard institutional web applications effectively.
