

Workshop for teachers on Strategies for Effective Class Room Management by Dr. Varadharajan

On June 5th, 2024, our school hosted an enlightening workshop by Dr. Varadharajan on “Strategies for Effective Classroom Management” for teachers. The session covered professional development, stressing the importance of listening during Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs) and closely observing students. Specific strategies for supporting slow learners were provided, along with advice on developing a positive mindset, understanding oneself and others, and accepting challenges. Teachers were encouraged to adopt a positive attitude, remain resourceful, inclusive, reflective, and innovative, and to incorporate storytelling and artistry into their teaching. The workshop concluded with a powerful message: “Our strength is their success, and our weakness is their failure,” encouraging teachers to design their classroom environments effectively.
